#### The Humility of Jesus

There is no more relatable moment of Jesus' humility than the account of when Jesus was left behind in Jerusalem at twelve years old. After realizing that Jesus was missing on their return trip from Jerusalem, Jesus' parents returned and found him in the temple courts. "Didn't you know I had to be in my Father's house?" Jesus would ask (Lk 2:49, ESV). His parents didn't understand what he meant, but he did. And even though he understood something about who he was, the text says "he went down to Nazareth with [his parents] and was obedient to them" (2:51). Many of us have submitted to our parents. Whether we were well-mannered or belligerent - whether our parents were right or wrong – we have submitted to our parents. Jesus knew at least something about his nature as a twelve-year-old but he submitted to his parents anyway. "Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men" (Phil 2:5-7). -Cooper Atkeson
