Maggie Castillo has asked for prayers that God will help her in her efforts to raise three girls.

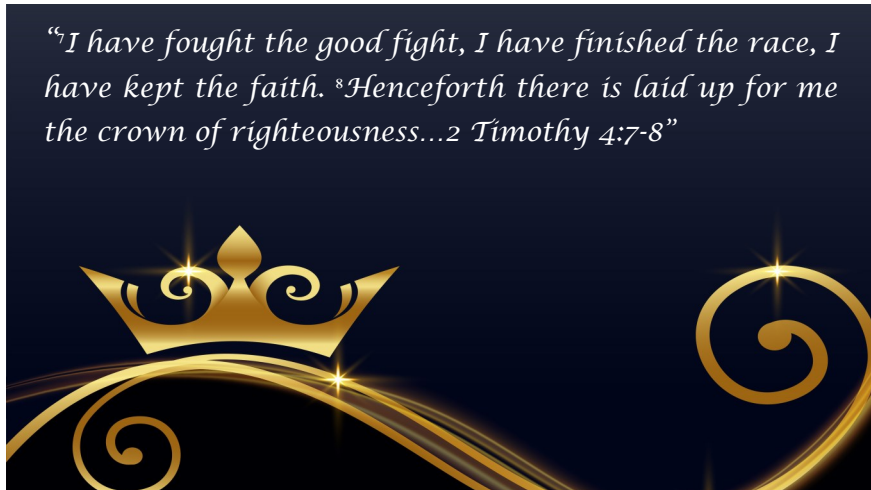
Barbara Dodd is scheduled for a procedure on October 13. Pray for comfort, and that the procedure will be successful.
